The District has to submit a preliminary plan to include 1 Superintendent and 1 Board for the District for the purpose of consolidating to receive the funds.

Estill Middle School – (1) Provide access control on exterior doors that do not currently have access control. Access controls installed on 3 Exterior Doors @ \$2,500.00/Door. (2) Re-key all doors to one master system. Rekey 40 existing non classroom and corridor doors @ \$100/door Estill High School – (1) Replace all exterior doors to main building and gymnasium building 16 sets of Exterior Doors (Pairs and Single Units) @ High School 8 sets of

		Exterior Doors (Pairs and Single Units) @ Gymnasium. (2) Provide access control on exterior doors. Access Controls installed on 5 exterior doors @ \$2,500.00/Door (HS). Access Controls installed on 3 exterior doors @ \$2,500.00/Door (Gym) (3) Provide security vestibule for main entrance. (4) Replace door hardware for security and one master keying system.
