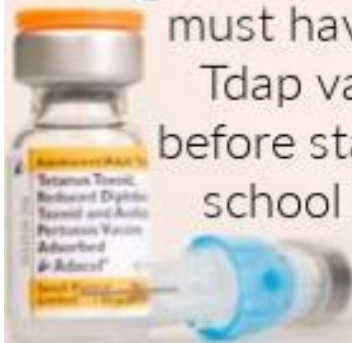

EHS Graduation Procedures

1. HCSO deputies, along with school staff, will be posted at the end of the school driveway- by the gate -on the Estill side of Hwy 321 to receive graduates and their guests.
2. Each guest will be expected to have a pre-printed ticket with the image of the graduate. Tickets will be collected, and each name will be annotated to ensure that no additional tickets have been forged.
3. Graduates will report to EHS campus, 7:30 a.m. on June 4, to line up and to receive their certification balloons, and to post their posters on the side of their cars. (If any graduate does not comply with the CDC guidelines, with regard to social distancing by remaining with their cars, they will be excluded from graduation and escorted off campus by the HCSO's Sheriff department.)
4. Spaces will be marked off in the field for guests. Parking will be conducted by staff members to ensure that everyone is able to see.
5. When you arrive on campus, you will not be allowed to exit your vehicle. Restrooms and entry to the building will not be allowed. Participants and guests will comply with CDC mandates as directed.
6. Once the ceremony begins, no one will be allowed to come on campus. The gate will be closed at 9:00.
7. Passwords for WiFi access to view the graduation on Facebook Live will be provided at the gate.
8. Officers will be placed at both gates, the back gate to the greenhouse, and the driveway to the Industrial park.
9. Staff members will perform the duties as marshals to assist in directing parking, monitoring processional & recession of graduates. They will also assist in the issuing of diplomas and gifts.
10. Graduates will be paraded on top of their cars to receive their diplomas and their gifts.
11. A photographer will be stationed at the front to take a picture of each graduate as they received their diploma. You will not be allowed to get out of your cars to take pictures. You will be allowed take pictures in town during the parade.
12. The graduates will go towards the main gate on the Luray side, return to their cars, and commence towards the Town of Estill; whereupon, they will meet the Junior marshals and the Estill Police Department.
13. The HCSO department along Estill Police department will escort the graduates down Hwy 321 towards Tyson's Auto Lot; thereby, concluding "EHS' Parade of Graduates.
