



Dear Estill High School Families,

On behalf of Estill High School's Faculty and Staff, we are overjoyed to share with you that on September 8, 2020 we will embark on a new journey for the 2020-2021 school year. We will open with your child's future educational and safety needs in mind. We are offering two learning models that will be able to suit the learning styles of all students: hybrid or virtual learning.

The hybrid model will require students to come to the school for two days of in person learning and three days of virtual learning. Virtual learning will take place at home Monday-Friday. When students are learning from home (hybrid and virtual) they will follow their schedule and join their classes through Microsoft Teams. Individual student schedules will be mailed out with the students' A/B day located at the bottom of the schedule. If your child will be taking the bus, they will report to school on the A/B day that is listed.

Due to the recent events surrounding the COVID-19 Pandemic, we have made some changes in our building and have modified some of our daily operations. We will review all of that information on August 31, 2020 during our virtual online orientation. We will start at 6:00 pm. A link will be provided to all parents to ask any questions prior to the meeting. Please check Facebook, Parent Square and your email for the meeting link and question submission. Please make every effort to complete that questionnaire.

Please note that our plans are tentative and will be monitored and adjusted as needed to ensure the safety of everyone.
