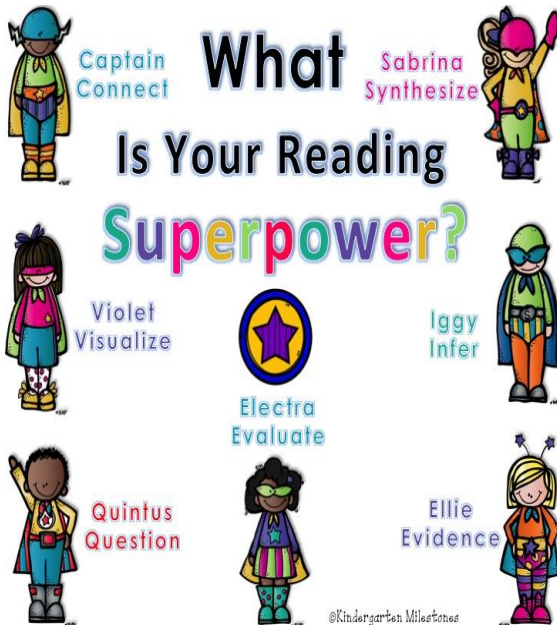

Suggest keeping a travel diary. If you know that your family will be traveling a great deal over the summer, suggest that your teen keep a travel diary or — more likely — a blog. Creative nonfiction is a really specific and powerful genre of writing that demands highly descriptive language and attention to detail. A travel blog will help your young writer develop skills and memorable content that might come in handy down the road, when it comes time to write college application essays.
