Back to School Procedures



Morning Arrival Procedures



- ✓ To ensure the safety of all, students <u>are not</u> to arrive before 7:45 a.m. Staff duty will begin at 7:45 a.m., therefore there will be no one to supervise students <u>before</u> 7:45 a.m.
- ✓ Car riders are to be dropped off in the designated car rider drop off area beginning at 7:45 a.m. Cars are not allowed in the bus line. This is a safety hazard.
- ✓ Bus riders will be dropped off in front of the main entrance of Estill High School.
- ✓ Students are to report to the cafeteria between 7:45 a.m. 8:07 a.m. The doors of the middle school building will open at 8:07 a.m. for students.
- ✓ Students that arrive after 8:10 a.m. must have a pass from the front office. To obtain a pass to class, the student **must** be signed in by their parent.
- ✓ Homeroom begins at 8:10 a.m.

Afternoon Dismissal Procedures

- ✓ Car riders will be dismissed at 3:30 p.m. They will walk on the sidewalk from the EMS campus to the designated car rider area in front of the EHS building. For the safety of all, staff members will be there to monitor.
- All changes to bus transportation must be approved by Marcus Livingston, Director of Transportation by telephone (625-5022) before 2:30 p.m.
- ✓ All students must be picked up by 3:40 p.m. There is no one to monitor or supervise students after this time.

Early Pick-Up or Late Drop Off

To ensure the safety of all of our students, please follow our early sign-out and late drop off procedures:

- ✓ Students will be released to authorized person(s) listed on the Student's Information Card only.
- ✓ Authorized person(s) must report to the school's front office to present their photo ID before the student is released from class.

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Contrl (DHEC) wants to assure that all children and teens have receive recommended vaccines to prevent disease.
