

Lexiles - Help Improve Your Child's Reading!

LEXILE MEASURES FOR BOOKS A Lexile text measure tells you how challenging a text is to comprehend. Over 100 million books and articles have Lexile measures. Lexile measures assess text characteristics (such as vocabulary and sentence length) and do not consider age-appropriateness or prior knowledge.



A Lexile reader measure describes your child's reading ability. Your child receives a Lexile measure from STAR 360 reading and SC Ready ELA assessments. Choosing books in your child's comprehension "sweet spot" (100L below to 50L above your child's reported Lexile measure) provides an ideal level of challenge for independent reading. To see how your child's reading ability compares to other students at the same grade level, visit Lexile.com/parents/graderanges.

HOW TO USE LEXILE MEASURES

Step 1: Ask your child for their Lexile number. Lexiles can also be found on their SC Ready ELA 2019 Spring report.

Step 2: FIND "JUST RIGHT" BOOKS Use our free "Find a Book" tool (fab.lexile.com) to find books that match your child's interests and reading level. Lexile measures are also widely available in bookstores, classrooms, libraries, and online.

Step 3: MONITOR GROWTH Lexile measures allow you to track growth from year to year. To be ready for the reading requirements of college and career, research says that high school graduates should be reading around 1300L.

The assessment guides greater student growth as we lead students toward mastery of state-specific learning standards for reading, math, and early literacy.
